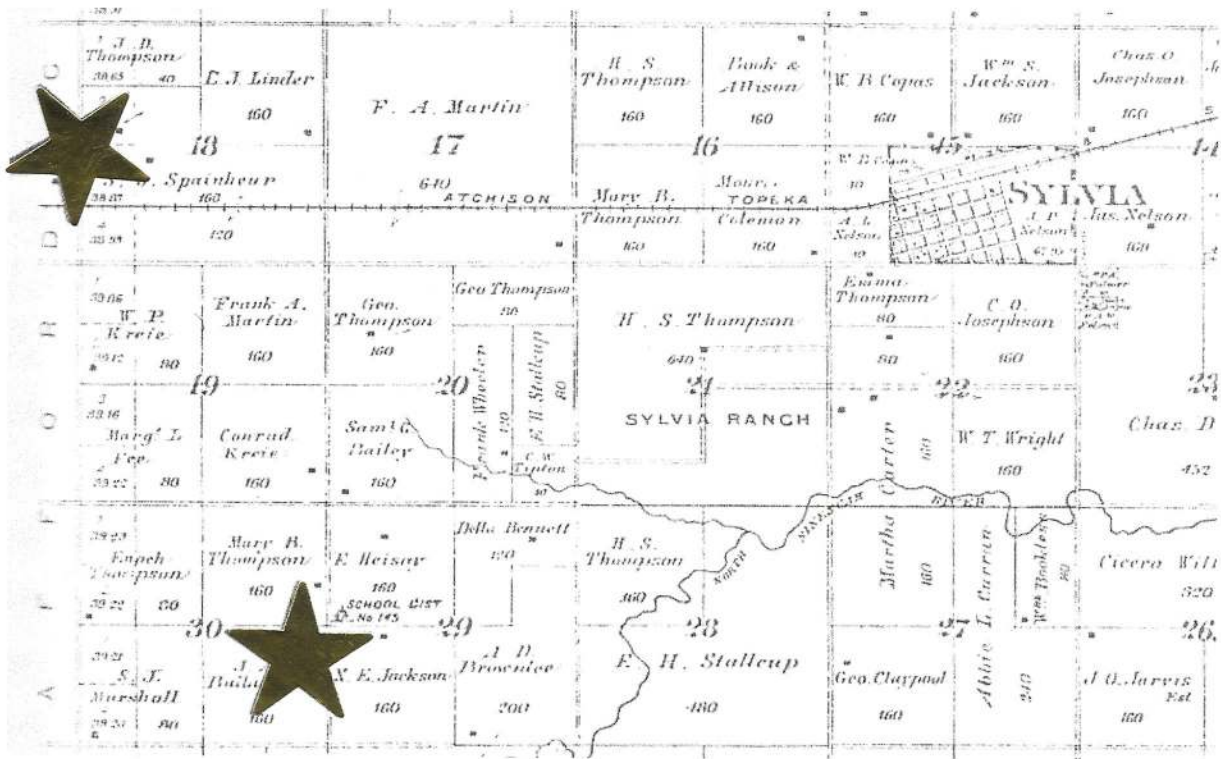


Portion of 1902 Plat of Sylvia Township



Star at top represents the location of Allen Marshall's birth at home in 1931.

He was born in Reno County on the Stafford County line about a quarter mile north of the railroad tracks. In 1931 those tracks belonged to the Atchison, Topeka and Sante Fe Railway (ATSF). Today the line is called BNSF since ATSF and the Burlington Northern Railroad merged in 1996.

Reno County maps today refer to the county line as Salt Marsh Road.

Bottom star represents the location of Sargent School. You can see the school building represented on the map and the notation: "School District No. 145"

Reno County maps today refer to the north-south road where the school once stood as Raymond Road. The road a half-mile north is Red Rock Road; the road a half-mile south is Greenfield Road.
